ACTIVITIES

During September and October we are busy with displays and stalls in and around Mandurah.

Our main event for the year is our Native Plant Day which includes Rare and Unusual native plants. This is held at the Senior Citizens Centre on the last Saturday in May.

We also have a stall at the Miami Village Shopping Centre in Autumn and in Spring. Members learn how to propagate native plants via seed and cuttings mornings and potting-up mornings.

Our Club also takes part in the Mandurah Garden Club Show in October each year.
